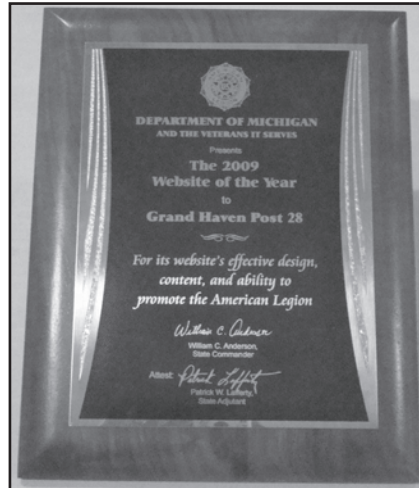




2009 PICNIC
