3 things this month:

 Vietnam Service Medal recipients— The US Court of Appeals for Veterans Claims decision extends the presumption of service connection for diseases related to Agent Orange exposure to Vietnam veterans who served on vessels that sailed in the waters off of the Republic of Vietnam, even though they did not set foot on shore. You may want to get going on a claim. Everything is in the appeal process but claims are still being accepted. I can help.

2) I can also help if anyone wants to apply for all medals awarded

during your service to our country.

3) If you are VA rated at 40% or more disabled and have had your house modified to accommodate the disability CONTACT me. You may be eligible for significant tax exemptions. My contact info is at Post28.
