THE FALLEN HEROES MONUMENT fund is continuing somewhat slowly but we have achieved a major milestone in its progress. The funds donated in our association with the Grand Haven Area Community Foundation have gone over the \$100,000.00 mark. This has been achieved since our association with the Foundation in March 2010.

With the available funds we had raised prior to our association with the Foundation we still need \$25,000.00 to be raised to achieve our goal of \$130,000.00.

We have continued to work in progressing physically with the Monument. Last month (May) we had the concrete foundation poured in Central Park. So if you walk through the park area you will see where the Monument will be located.

Our Monument supplier has advised us of a delay in the Monument delivery. They had earlier advised us it would be here in April or May but after having cut 3 granite slabs for it out of the quarry the supplier discovered two of them had cracks in them and couldn't be used. So they had to cut new ones and they are advising us delivery of them is early fall.

As a result of the new delivery schedule the committee has now tentatively set the dedication date as Veterans Day, (November 11, 2011).
