Fallen Heroes Memorial Monument Committee

The Fallen Heroes committee has now received the identification plaque and support stand (all paid for) and have ordered the 3 section granite memorial as well as the eagle to be placed on top of the monument. We had to pay [] the cost with the orders which amounted to \$59,625.00. This used up most of the funds we had received from donations. We will have to pay the other half on the receipt of the eagle (\$4,125.00) in about 3 months and the other half of the monument (\$55,500.00) in about 6 months when it is installed. We have about \$8,000.00 available and will use most of that (about \$5,000.00) when we install the foundation.

The committee has one more perch dinner on November 3, at the post. All proceeds from the dinner will go to the Memorial.

So we are still asking for donations from our Legion, Auxiliary, SAL, and Rider memberships. Please continue to contribute.

Sweet Potatoes	3 cups yams
1/2 cup sugar	1/2 cup butter
2 beaten eggs	1 teaspoon vanilla
1/3 cup milk	

Mix and place in sprayed 9 x 13 pan.

Topping: melt 1/3 cup butter and add 1 cup brown sugar, 1/2 cup flour and 1 cup chopped pecans. Sprinkle over top of yams, bake at 350 degrees for 25 minutes. Serves 10 - 12.
